

Small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) are the backbone of the European economy with strong contributions to employment, growth of economy, innovation and entrepreneurship.

They employ more than two thirds of the EU labour force, contribute to more than half of EU value added and have played an important role in the recovery since the financial and economic crisis.

They therefore deserve dedicated support and attention in an attempt to thrive and continue contributing to the developing Europe^{1,2}.

Introduction EU Support to SMEs

The EU will support SMEs in 3 key areas:



The sustainable and digital transitions



of EU SMEs work on green products or services



of SMEs have successfully integrated digital technologies, compared to 54% of large companies

Based on the new SME Strategy:

- Sustainability Advisors will be appointed within the existing Enterprise Europe Network to help SMEs with environmental and social challenges and improve access to skills.
- Up to 240 Digital Innovation Hubs will advise SMEs on how to integrate digital innovations into their products, business models and processes.
- The new European Innovation Council (EIC) will make available €300 million as of next year to encourage breakthrough innovations delivering Green Deal objectives.

Introduction EU Support to SMEs



Doing business freely in the Single Market and beyond, notably by cutting red tape

SMEs need improved access to markets. The SME strategy will reduce barriers within the Single Market and open up access to finance to cover the investment needed for the ecological and digital transition.

Challenges

Actions



While 80% of exporting SMEs sell their products and services on the Single Market, certain sectors like services face more obstacles. And only 600,000 SMEs export goods outside of the EU



Partnerships among border regions to encourage them to jointly improve, align or coordinate the rules and procedures on cross-border provision of services, for example, on posting of workers and using digital tools. And an extended Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs Global Scheme to support internationalisation



Only 40% of businesses in the EU are paid on time. This is the cause of ¼ of SME bankruptcies



Support Member States in implementing the **Late Payment Directive,** by setting up monitoring and enforcement tools



78% of SMEs cite complex administrative procedures as the biggest obstacle to operating in the Single Market



Develop an **EU Start-up Nations Standard** with Member States to accelerate growth of high tech SMEs and start-ups in the Single Market

Hurdles to accessing finance



Only 10% of European SMEs' external financing is from capital markets



Only 11% of businesses in Europe consider equity as a viable financing option while only 1% have used it

Venture capital investments in Europe are many times smaller than in the US, with three times fewer scale-ups



Creating an SME Initial Public Offering

Actions

(IPO) Fund with investments channelled through a new private-public fund set up under the InvestEU programme and launching a gender-smart finance initiative to stimulate funding for femaleled companies and funds



Create the ESCALAR initiative, a mechanism to boost the size of venture capital funds and attract more private investment, to help high-potential enterprises to grow



Support Policies and Events for SMEs in EU


EU has established a lot of different policies and events for SMEs.

The support bodies are related to either **strategy**, **networking**, **entrepreneurship** and **education** and are available for all the SMEs across Europe ^{1,2,3}.





Support Bodies for SMEs in EU-Enterprise Europe Network





- Composed by more than 3,000 professionals

COSME aims to support SMEs in the following areas:

- Encouraging an entrepreneurial culture


COSME is a programme implementing the Small Business Act (SBA) which reflects the Commission's political will to recognise the central role of SMEs in the EU economy ⁴.

Eurochambres represents over 20 million businesses in Europe through 45 members (43 national associations of chambers of commerce and industry and two transnational chamber organisations) and a European network of 1700 regional and local chambers ^{7.}





Support Bodies for SMEs in EU-Enterprise Europe Network



SME2B fosters a continuous match-making process by organising online and offline meeting for business opportunities in Europe among entrepreneurs of different countries.^{9.}

What can you do on SME2B?

- Present services and products in an interactive marketplace.
- Search, filter and find a business partner fast and easily.
- Meet potential business partners directly through virtual meeting spaces ⁹.



Support Bodies for SMEs in EU-European Digital Innovation HUBs

European Digital Innovation HUBs (EDIHs)

are operating at local and European level. The EDIHs were created so that digital expertise transfer will be facilitated according to the "Digital Europe" Programme. EDIHs will aid enterprises during their digitalization process so that they become more competitive⁸.

The Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF) for the programming period 2021 − 2027 includes (in current prices) a total of €2.18 trillion (1210.9 Long Term Budget and 806.9 Next Generation EU) ¹⁰.



Funding Opportunities for SMEs in EU-Funding Bodies/Tools

Different Funding tools and bodies are available in the EU for SMEs ^{11,} 12,13,14,15

National Strategic Reference Framework that is funded by European Regional Development Fund (EDRF), provides in each EU country, funding for SMEs through Operational or Sectoral Programmes 11, 12,13,14,15 SMEs, depending on their areas of interest may be eligible to apply to specific funded programmes in the EU ^{11, 12,13,14,15}.



A business angel is a private individual, who directly invests part of their assets in new and growing private businesses. Besides capital, angel investors usually provide business management experience, skills and contacts for the entrepreneur. They are increasingly important as providers of risk capital and contributors to economic growth and technological advances¹⁶.

Depending on how much capital a company needs, using personal funds might be the best option. Personal Funds - Self funding your business means providing the initial funds to start your business through your own personal means.

The most common funding for small businesses comes from the founders'/owners' personal savings.

Self funding allows the owners/founders of a business to retain equity in the business without saddling the business with ongoing debt payments during its early stages¹⁷.

If you want to retain complete control of your business, but don't have enough funds to start, consider a small business loan.

To increase your chances of securing a loan:

- have a business plan
- expense sheet
- financial projections for the next five years.

These tools will give you an idea of how much you'll need to ask for, and will help the bank know they're making a smart choice by giving you a loan¹¹.
